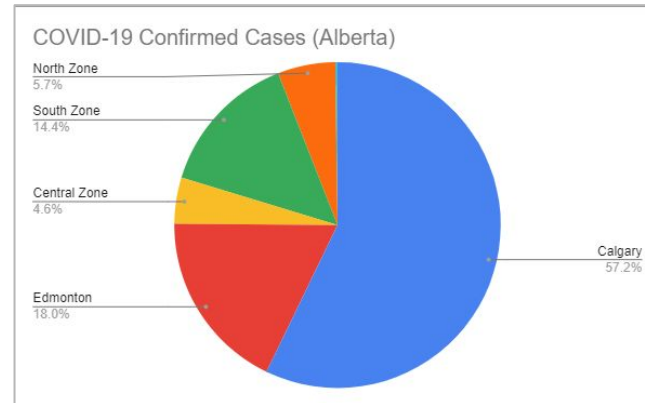
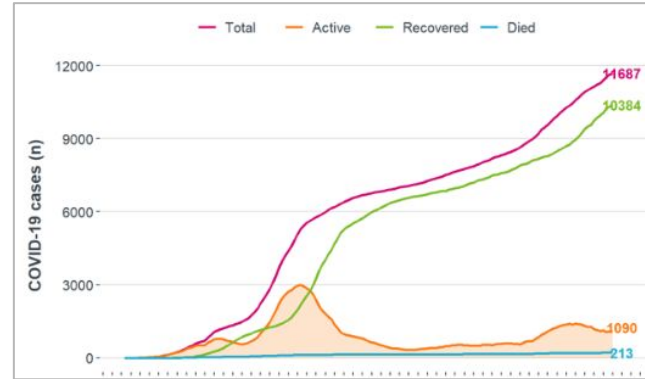

COVID-19 Update Edmonton Health Data (08/12)

Indicator	Trend
Total to Date	2136
Active cases	470
New cases	95
Hospitalizations	21
Infection Rate per 100,000	46
Deaths	55
Outbreak Locations	11



Mandatory Face Coverings Update

- Effective August 1 - December 31, 2020
- Current compliance is strong
 - General Business 98%
 - Recreation Centres 96%
 - Transit 82%
 - Vehicle for Hire 92%
- Education and reinforcement to increase participation
- Exemption card program for those not able to wear a face covering where otherwise required

Mandatory Face Coverings Bylaw - Possible Future Amendments

- Current exemptions are consistent and no significant gaps have been identified to date
- Opportunity to reassess the minimum age exemption of 2 years
- Increased fine amount for non-compliance
- Potential future offence for improper claiming of an exemption

- EXPO Centre - isolation centre extension and long term options
- EPL - Churchill Square day programming
- Central Lions Centre temporary shelter extension
- Government of Alberta Funding

	Description	Timing
1	The Hallway Cafe opens (separate from the main building)	August 17
2	Guidelines developed for Councillors' offices to hold meetings with the public, by appointment only	End of August
3	Pre-registered speakers/attendees may attend City Council and Committee meetings in-person	September 14
4	Return to work of civic employees at City Hall	TBD - to align with corporate guidelines
5	City Hall and Parkade open to public for general access and other services	TBD - based on success of phases 1-3
