Advancing the Waste Strategy in a Pandemic

- Leading by example in 240+ City owned and operated buildings, facilities, attractions and amenities
- Education, outreach and technical assistance help to inform future ICI programming and supports





ICI Sector in Edmonton

- Not part of the regulated utility, serviced by the private sector
- 34,000+ businesses as well as schools, hospitals and not-for-profits
- Estimated 770,000 tonnes of waste
- Average city
 - o 37% organics
 - 49% recycling with diversion potential




25-year Waste Strategy

- 90 percent waste diversion target for all sectors
- Commitment to regulate ICI sector for three-stream source separation
- Consistent sorting expectations across all sectors will help to reinforce habits and improve community-level performance
- Path to 90% diversion will require a waste to energy or waste to biofuels option

- Engagement with industry (Q4 2021 Q2 2022)
 - Regulatory considerations
 - Alignment of processing capacity
 - Potential for staged enforcement
- Recommended provisions for a three-stream separation bylaw in Q2 2022
