

Prairie Sky Gondola - Council Approved Principles

Council's February 3rd, 2020 Motion:

That Administration continue to work with Prairie Sky Gondola to determine the feasibility of a gondola in the River Valley, with the work to be guided by:

- 1. The following governing principles:
 - a. No public funding requested and all financial risk borne by proponents
 - Open books to the city for validation on a confidential and proprietary basis
 - c. A robust engagement plan for community and Indigenous stakeholders
 - d. Mutually beneficial integration with public transit
 - e. Minimized ecological footprint
 - f. Providing surety, including monetary security, with respect to service continuity or demobilization
- 2. An examination of the implications of using air rights and of an emergency response plan for first responders.




Project Concept Update

- → Analyzed:
 - Technical viability of the proposed gondola and alignment with City strategic documents in line with the current phase
 - Prairie Sky Gondola Business Case and Financial Model, confidentially
- → Examined:
 - Impacted lands and recommended approaches for future land agreements at market value
- → Identified:
 - Risk mitigation approaches
 - Expected next steps, including regulatory processes, rezoning requirements, and necessary alignment with City plans and projects
- → Developed:
 - Framework Agreement for Council consideration
