

THE CITY OF EDMONTON
BYLAW 5590
TRAFFIC BYLAW Amendment No. #19518

Edmonton City Council enacts:

1. Bylaw 5590, Traffic Bylaw, is amended by this bylaw.
2. The following is added as subsection 2(aa.2):

(aa.2) **“tow truck”** means a vehicle operated on a highway to provide one of the following services: towing, moving, or recovering motor vehicles that are damaged, disabled, abandoned, tagged, or ticketed, and for greater certainty, includes vehicles used for the provision of ancillary towing services such as traffic control and the solicitation of tow truck services.

3. Subsection 59(3) is deleted and replaced with:

(3) Notwithstanding subsection (1) a pedestrian may cross at any point other than a crosswalk in any area designated as a shared street provided that the right of way is yielded to vehicles on the roadway.

4. Subsection 59(4) is repealed.

5. Section 80 is deleted and replaced with the following:

80(1) A person operating a tow truck shall not attend on the scene of a damaged, disabled, abandoned, tagged, or ticketed vehicle on a highway unless previously requested to do so by an owner or driver of the vehicle or by a peace officer.

(2) For the purpose of this section any individual or corporation referred to on or by a tow truck, whether directly or indirectly, is presumed to have caused or permitted the tow truck to attend.

6. Subsection 86(4) of the Traffic Bylaw is renumbered as subsection 86(5).

7. The following is added as subsection 86(4):

(4) An annual road ban is permanent unless a shorter period is designated.

8. The following is added as subsection 86(6):

(6) Notwithstanding subsection (1), a person may operate a vehicle on a highway that is subject to a road ban and exceed the axle weight restrictions imposed by that road ban if the City issues a permit to that person allowing them to do so.

9. Subsection 89(5) of the Traffic Bylaw is repealed.

10. Subsection 107(gg) is amended by deleting the word “and”.

11. Subsection 107(hh) is renumbered as subsection 107(ii).

12. The following is added as subsection 107(hh):

(hh) designate portions of any highway as either a permanent or temporary shared street; and
