Report

Bylaw 18816 to amend the Glenridding Ravine Neighbourhood Structure Plan (NSP) proposes to redistribute the low and medium residential uses and to add an institutional land use designation. An associated amendment to the Windermere ASP (Bylaw 18815) and rezoning (Charter Bylaw 18817) are being proposed concurrently.

Public Engagement

An advance notice was sent to surrounding property owners and the Greater Windermere and Heritage Point Community Leagues, on October 23, 2019. No responses were received.
