Economic Forecast Adjustments

- Increased assessment growth
 - \$3.8 million increase in 2019
- Corporate revenues and expenditures
 - \$5.4 million net change in 2019
- Edmonton Police Service
 - \$0.5 million net increase for cannabis and victim services offices
