Bill 56: the Local Measures Statutes Amendment Act, 2021

- Introduced on March 11, 2021
- Capital funding for City of Edmonton
 - No additional changes from Budget 2021 released on February 25
 - Confirmation of planned reductions and delay of the Local Government Fiscal Framework (LGFF)
 - If passed, effective April 1, 2021
- 911 Levy
 - Increase in monthly 911 levy from 41 cents to 95 cents
 - Used to fund new federally mandated 911 technology upgrades
 - If passed, effective September 1, 2021

Edmonton & Calgary	\$455M (52.9% of total)	\$382M (52.9% of total)
Other municipalities/ Metis settlements	\$405M	\$340M
Total LGFF	\$860M	\$722M
