Report Summary

This bylaw amends Bylaw 19407, Community Safety and Well-being Task Force Bylaw, to extend the delivery date for the Task Force's final report to Council and to remove remuneration for the Chair of the Task Force.

Report

Bylaw 19407, Community Safety and Well-being Task Force Bylaw, reads:

5 To carry out its mandate, the Community Safety and Well-being Task Force must:

(c) no later than March 31, 2021, provide a written report to Council with recommendations arising from the work described in subsections (a) and (b).

The proposed bylaw extends the due date for the written report to Council to April 30, 2021, to allow the Task Force to complete its work.

In addition, the proposed bylaw removes any compensation for the Chair provided for in Bylaw 19407. The Chair has indicated that they are not in a position to accept any remuneration and therefore have asked for this requirement to be removed from the Bylaw, which requires City Council approval.
