- 311, no callback from bylaw, file closed
- 911 EFD responded to 6 calls
- Crematoriums notify EFD to avoid response

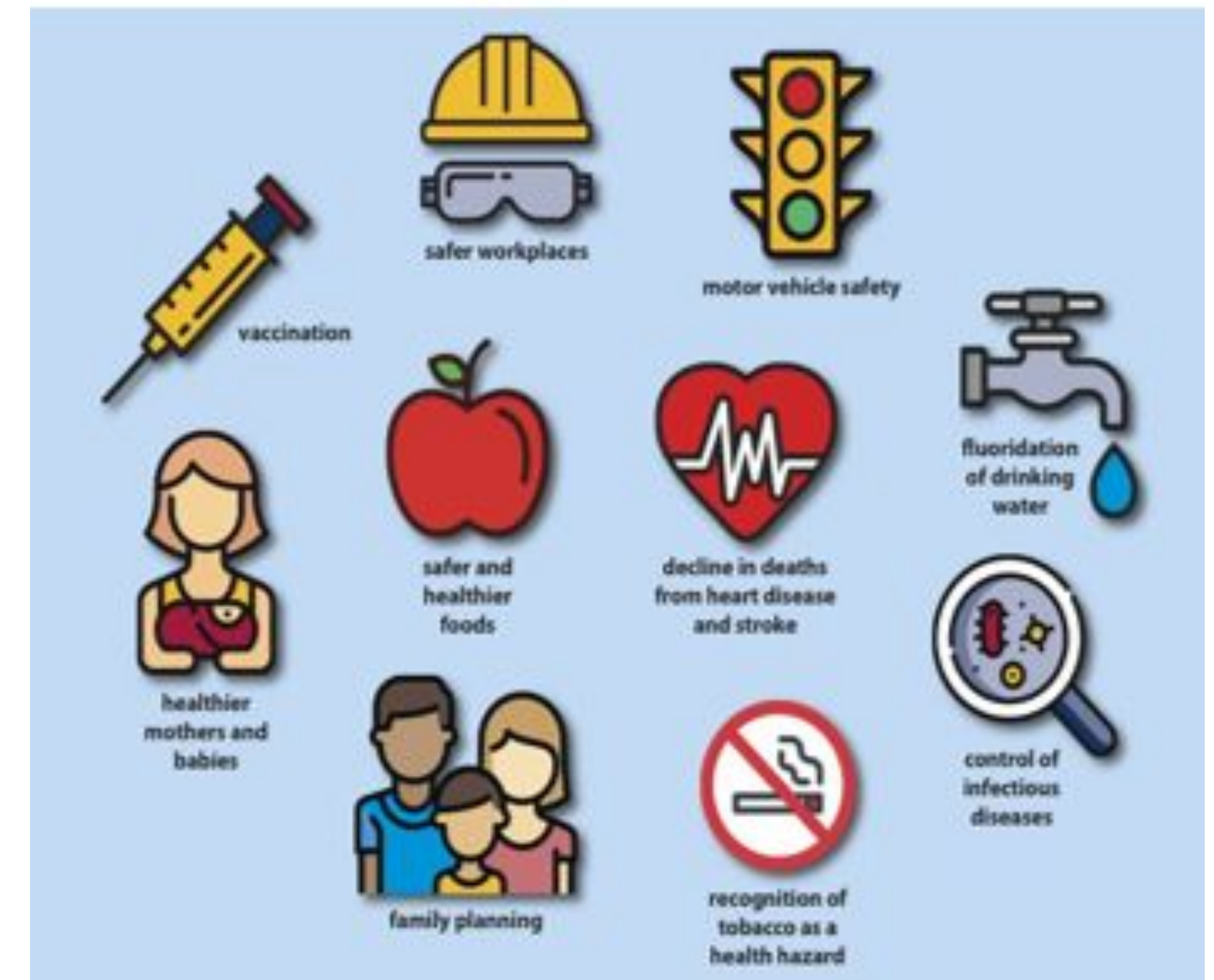

- Legislation 1993, heavy industry focus
- Crematoriums exempt under Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act
- Exempt for the Code of Practice for Small Incinerators
- Suggested contact COE as municipal bylaw issue

Environmental Public Health (AHS)

- “Environmental Public Health does not regulate crematoriums. I recommend you contact the Alberta Funeral Services Regulatory Board which has jurisdiction for crematoriums and the City of Edmonton which is responsible for zoning. You may wish to connect with Alberta Environment as well.”

Cemetery Act: Crematory Regulation

- “The owner of a crematory shall ensure that the crematory is maintained in good order and is operated so that it does not give rise to any offences of public health nuisance”.
- Delegates technical aspect to AFSRB
- Environmental Public Health



Alberta Funeral Services Regulatory Board

- “Some of the concerns that the AFSRB does not have authority over and therefore unable to investigate are: environmental issues such as crematory emissions (the AFSRB does not have expertise or authority to investigate air quality, however we can confirm proper operating procedures and processes are followed)”

Capital City Airshed

- Ambient Air locations insufficient to measure and monitor emissions
- Mercury
- Interested in community concerns
