Fuel Storage Tank Program

- Mandatory for any business with fuel tanks 2500L or more.
- Program previously administered by the Petroleum Tank Management Association of Alberta.
- \$75 registration fee; same as previous program.
- Revenue potential.

Action required

Update Schedule B to reflect the registration fee.

Fireworks Permits: Overview

Vendor Permit

- Critical for vendor accountability
- 3 vendors in Edmonton (currently)
- \$99 permit fee

Tier I Permit

- Consumer fireworks only
- Private property
- No public audience
- No charge for permit

Tier II Permit

- Community events
- Public audience
- \$147 Consumer Permit
- \$181 Display Permit (high level)

Fireworks Vendor Permit

- Vendor permits were previously required under the Alberta Fire Code.
 - In December 2019, these conditions were removed.
 - Each municipality is responsible for their own terms.
- Administration is recommending reinstating a vendor permit.

Action required

Update Bylaw 15309 to introduce provisions for selling fireworks.

Fireworks Vendor Permit

Rationale for vendor permit:

- Ensure vendors follow federal regulations.
- Ensure vendors advise on the proper products that can be safely discharged, as per federal regulations.
- Allows Administration enforcement abilities if safety requirements are not followed.
