The following projects have been established:

- 124 Street renewal including upgrades to the business improvement area and pedestrian lighting and safety
- Neighbourhood renewal-related upgrades to address lighting safety issues in Linear Park, creation of spaces and seating areas that increase the likelihood of neighbours connecting with one another (e.g. walkability and “bumping” places) as well as improved landscaping in John A. Norris Park

In Balwin/Belvedere, through recent public engagement, community members have indicated the desire to explore the following:

- beautification enhancements to Fort Road, 66 Street and 132 Avenue
- neighbourhood-wide traffic calming assessments and improvements with an emphasis on pedestrian safety in busy intersections and crosswalks
- neighbourhood-wide assessment of lighting and investment to increase a sense of safety
- creation of inviting and engaging parks and green spaces through the installation of desirable amenities and enhancements

Each revitalization area will access the revitalization capital budget to identify, prioritize and follow through on investments.
