Executive Summary

The Edmonton Transit Service Advisory Board reports its activities of the past calendar year and planned future activities for the upcoming year on an annual basis.

Report

The Edmonton Transit Service Advisory Board (ETSAB) was established in September 1994 to provide advice and recommendations to Urban Planning Committee from a stakeholder perspective on issues related to public transit.

The Edmonton Transit Service Advisory Board (ETSAB) had two productive years in 2019-20 and 2020-21, making several presentations and issuing reports and other correspondence on various topics within its mandate. The Board's activities to highlight opportunities to improve transit service have led to tangible benefits in Edmonton's transit system with the consideration and response of Administration and Council. In 2019, 2020 and 2021, three new reports were presented by ETSAB to Committees of Council, two letters were issued to Councillors and copied to Edmonton Transit Service Administration, and ETSAB registered to speak to budget adjustments.

ETSAB looks forward to continuing these collaborative efforts in 2021-22.
