

Fare Policy Supports for Edmontonians

- Fare- free transit for seniors who experience low income
- Sliding scale model added for seniors passes
- Children 12 & under ride for free with fare-paying rider
- Family day pass added, family of 5 can have unlimited rides in a day (\$10.25)
- Low income transit pass program

- Discounted trip rate for book of tickets
- Youth monthly pass price decreased
- Youth/seniors ticket price decreased
- PATH program expanded to provide 1,900 free monthly passes to houseless Edmontonians
- Sliding scale model added for Ride Transit

Fare-related Decision Timeline

Fall 2017; Transit Strategy Approved & Ride Transit launches

Dec 2018; 2019-22 Budget approved, including fares

Dec 2019; 2020 cash fare increase cancelled 2021 cash fare increase deferred to May 1, 2021

Other 2021 Fare increases
Approved

Spring/Summer 2018; Fare Policy Engagement & Free Transit for 12 & Under approved

Fall 2019; Day Pass expanded; Fare Policy approved March 2020; Seniors' sliding scale approved Smart Fare flat fee proposal added to fee schedule
