		(c)	hate and extremism;	
		(d)	racial equity;	
		(e)	anti-Black racism;	
		(f)	racism against Indigenous Peoples;	
		(g)	xenophobia;	
		(h)	islamophobia;	
		(i)	antisemitism; and	
		(j)	the lived experiences of persons of colour.	

- 3. Section 5(a) is deleted and replaced with:
 - (a) identify and ensure equitable engagement of stakeholder groups and seek their input into the Committee's work;

- 4. Section 5(b)(i) is deleted and replaced with:
 - (i) address racially motivated hate;
- 5. Section 5(c) is deleted and replaced with:
 - conduct research, prepare reports on community-based issues and concerns, and (c) complement existing structures by providing recommendations on programs and services and their priorities; and
- 6. Section 5(d) is deleted and replaced with:
 - (d) work with the City Manager to develop and maintain a dialogue about, and take action on, matters of concern to stakeholders in relation to anti-racism.
- Section 7 is amended by deleting and replacing "13" with "17". 7.
- 8. Section 7 is renumbered as section 6.
- 9. Section 8 is renumbered as section 7.
