## *History*

- At the January 30, 2019, Community and Public Services Committee meeting, the January 30, 2019, City Operations report CR\_6697, the January 30, 2019, City Operations report CR\_6325 and the January 30, 2019, City Operations report CR\_6326 were considered and dealt with together and the Committee heard from R. Labbe. The following motions were passed:

### **6.6 - Anomalous Speed Zones – Councillor Consultation:**

That the January 30, 2019, City Operations report CR\_6325, be received for information.

### **6.8 - Playground Zone Guidelines:**

That Administration provide a high-level report on further refinement of the Playground Zone Guideline, to consider but not be limited to the following:

1. mitigating efforts other than establishing a playground zone at a reviewed location
2. further mitigating efforts (eg. Speed bumps) at problematic playground zone locations
3. a more comprehensive list of local context characteristics (eg. Visibility issues, hills, curves), either with or without point assignments
4. process to establish speed reduction zones at locations other than playground, field or school locations.
