

Bylaw 19712

Smart Fare Implementation

Recommendation

That Executive Committee recommend to City Council:

That Bylaw 19712 be given the appropriate readings.

Purpose

To amend the current Conduct of Transit Passengers bylaw to include the Regional Smart Fare Solution.

Readings

Bylaw 19712 is ready for three readings.

A majority vote of City Council on all three readings is required for passage.

If Council wishes to give three readings during a single meeting, then prior to moving third reading, Council must unanimously agree “That Bylaw 19712 be considered for third reading.”

Position of Administration

Administration supports this Bylaw.

Report Summary

This Bylaw is to update the Conduct of Transit Passengers Bylaw to include language for the Regional Smart Fare Solution.

Report

The implementation of the Regional Smart Fare Solution requires an update to the Conduct of Transit Passengers Bylaw to include language that will allow the account-based card system to be governed appropriately and enable busses to be proof of payment zones which adds additional enforcement options.

Administration has also taken this opportunity to include clerical housekeeping amendments to Bylaw 8353.
