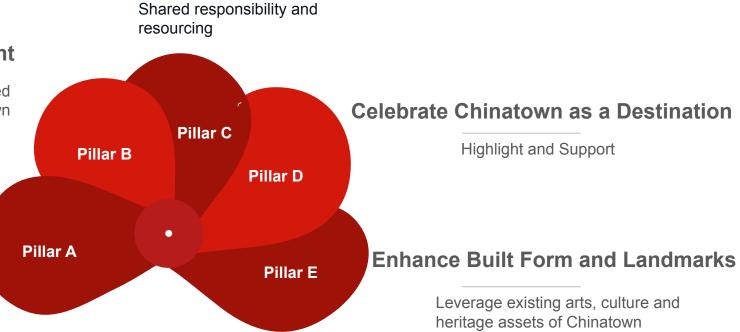

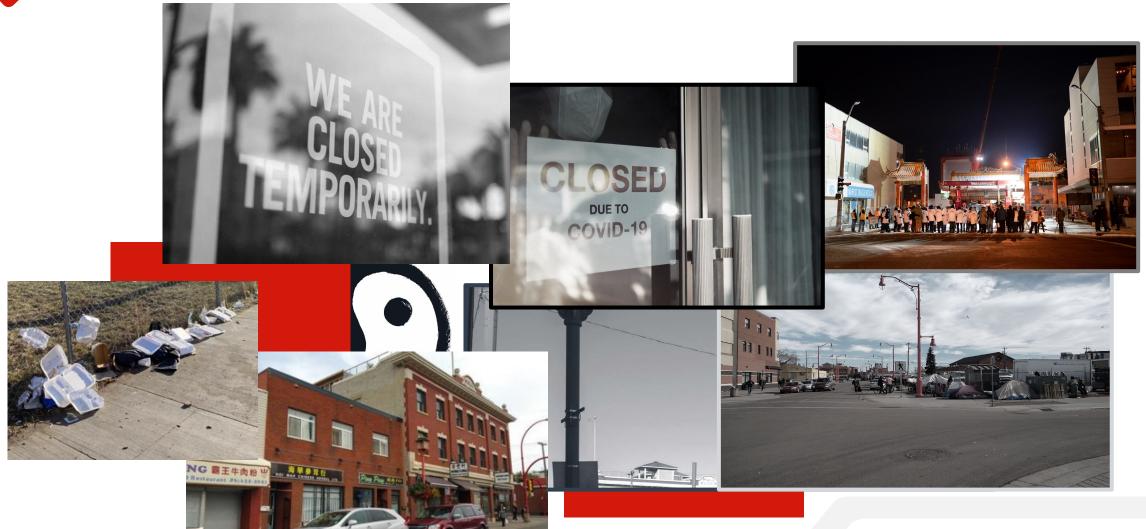

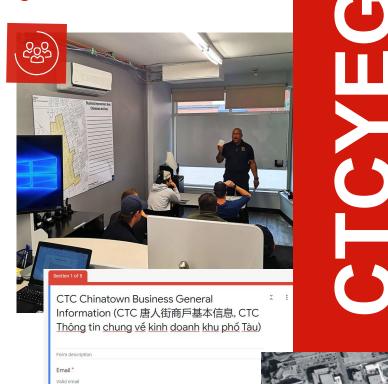

Door to door survey

- 70+ Chinatown businesses and organizations have been surveyed.

Expand CTC membership

- -Non-voting membership has increased from 0 on Oct 2020 to 60 on April 2021.
- -Voting Membership has increased from 13 to 20.

Security team patrol

-A 2 months long pilot Chinatown patrol program.





Online and Offline Events

- -Collaborated with CBA in Dongzhi Event.
- -Gift & coupon giveaways.
- -Collaborated with Chinatown iPharmacy to launched flu info session.
- -Chinese Lunar New Year event.
- -Summer walking tour.
- -Long Table Feast.

Active Social Media Accounts

- -From less than 50 to almost 500 followers.
- -Following almost 700 active relevant accounts.
- -Steady growth Insights across multiple platforms.
- -Synchronous updates of content across multiple platforms.
- -Increased Media exposure of CTC to the public, raising the concern of Chinatown.

Chinatown National Action Plan

-Gather with other Chinatown leads such as Montreal, Vancouver, Toronto, Saskatchewan, Calgary and Winnipeg to discuss Chinatown development in Canada.

Pave way for future events and activities

- -Prioritize and implement the actions under the Chinatown Strategy Pillars .
- -Took initiative to work with different NPOs, political activist, KOLs etc to seek further cooperation.







Vacant lots and buildings research

- -Discovered 26 vacant lots and 31 vacant buildings.
- -Updated Maps and inventories.

Lunar New Year related events and campaigns

- -Over 20 businesses offered discount for the week.
- -Spring couplet and gifts giveaway.
- -Photo booths.

Developed and enhanced CTC's public image

- -Media coverage by renowned broadcasting corporation such as CBC, CityNews, CTV news.
- -Delivering timely and bi-lingual Covid-19 information within Chinatown areas.







Utilized a highly-focused social media and content marketing strategy

- -Over 130 posts launched.
- -50 new launched relevant contents from Feb to end of Apr.
- -Added more diversified presentation forms.

Successful collaborated with University of Alberta & NAIT

- -5 Relevant partnership working with volunteers from the UoA Community Service Learning.
- -NAIT website, CTC logo, storefront and menu redesign
- Master/4th years student proposes strategy on marketing, fundraising and grant applications.
