Subject: **Revision to Bylaw 19134, Closure of a portion of the lane east of  
101 Street NW and north of 97 Avenue NW, Rossdale**

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Pursuant to section 63 of the *Municipal Government Act*, Council may, by bylaw, revise any of its bylaws by making non-substantive changes, including making changes, without materially affecting the bylaw in principle or substance,

- to correct clerical, technical, grammatical or typographical errors in a bylaw;
- to bring out more clearly what is considered to be the meaning of a bylaw, or
- to improve the expression of the law.

Before first reading of a revision bylaw, the City Manager must certify in writing that the proposed revisions have been prepared in accordance with section 63 of the *Municipal Government Act*. In 2019, the City Manager delegated this authority to the City Solicitor and the Director, Solicitors Section.
